Principal's News...

Welcome to the first week of term 1 2019!

Staff are all looking forward to the eager, happy faces that greet us especially warmly at the beginning of a new term.

It is a very busy start to the year and we will endeavour to keep you well informed in a timely fashion. I must urge you to read the newsletter each week as soon as it arrives as we have a lot happening!

Newsletters are sent home on Monday each week they are also available on our facebook page and school stream phone app.

- ♦ **Emergency and Medical update forms...** please ensure that these forms are returned to the office this week.
- ♦ **Waitangi Day...** Wednesday 6th February. School will be closed.
- ♦ **Welcome Nicole Hurley...** who has been appointed as our high health needs Teacher Aide. We have a child who has a **severe peanut allergy** (anaphylactic shock) and another child with a similar allergy enrolling in March. We are urging parents to restrict the peanut products in school lunchboxes if at all possible please. Room 3 lunchboxes will be checked daily and those containing nut products will be monitored carefully (handwashing, desk washing etc). Please contact me if you have any queries or concerns regarding this.
- ♦ **Swimming...** is a compulsory part of the curriculum, if your child isn't swimming we do need a note please. We will phone to check arrangements immediately after school as you may not be aware that your child is choosing not to swim or leaving togs at home.
- ♦ **Stationery...** All students will be expected to have their stationery by the end of Week 2. All items can be purchased through the school. If you do not have a stationery list please contact the office immediately.
- ♦ **Hats...** are COMPULSORY. All students **MUST** have a **NAMED** hat that is to be left **AT SCHOOL**.
- ♦ **School Stream Communication Mobile Phone App...** Please see instructions on how to download this communication app. We strongly encourage that you try this app. We will be posting school newsletters, permission forms and other notices to the app.
- ♦ **Bike Ride Fundraiser... WE NEED YOU ALL!** We need you all to help over the weekend of the 16th/17th February. This is our **ONLY** fundraiser and is a very big weekend. Close to 50% of those involved with the organisation have little or no involvement with the school yet turn up to support our school and our children. iPhone / iPad iOS

1. From your mobile device go to the **App Store** search for **School Stream**
2. Tap the **FREE/GET** button to the right of the School Stream listing
3. Tap the **INSTALL** button
4. Enter your Apple ID and password & tap **OK**
5. Wait for the install icon to change to **OPEN**
6. Tap the **OPEN** button

Android / Tablet

1. From your mobile device go to the **Play Store** search for **School Stream**
2. Tap the School Stream listing
3. Tap the **INSTALL** button
4. Tap the **ACCEPT** button
5. Wait for the app to install then tap the **OPEN** button
