An extra BIG thank you to those of you who worked for the entire weekend, some for three full days.

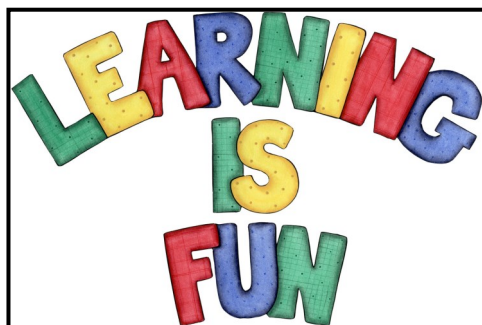
- ◆ **Class Newsletters...** All classes will be sending home newsletters outlining some of the programmes currently underway and other information of interest regarding that classroom.

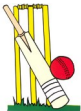
