Mid-Year Reporting to Parents

Teachers are currently working on two forms of assessment, which will be sent home with your children on Friday 28th June.

Written Reports - these include a comment on all curriculum areas and a general comment.

Formal assessment Folders - this clear file includes assessments of various units of work completed so far this year and will also have samples of work such as writing. These folders need to be returned to school by week 2 next term so that we can add work for the remainder of 2019. At the end of the year, they will be sent home to be retained by you as a record of your child's 2019 year at Aria School.

All assessment will have a teacher judgement of **well below** appropriate level, **just below**, **at level**, **just above** and **well above**. Generally, a child who is achieving well below or well above is about two years below or above where they should be achieving.

Interviews - these follow in the last week of term (however, you are welcome to make an appointment with your child's teachers at any other mutually agreed time). Please bring your child with you - if you wish to. **We will be contacting all families to arrange a suitable time, as it is very important to have your input into your children's learning journey.**

Staff have set aside **afternoons during week 10 (times yet to be decided).**

Interviews will be 15 minutes each. Next week when those days and times are published you are welcome to phone the office to make an interview time, otherwise we will phone you.
