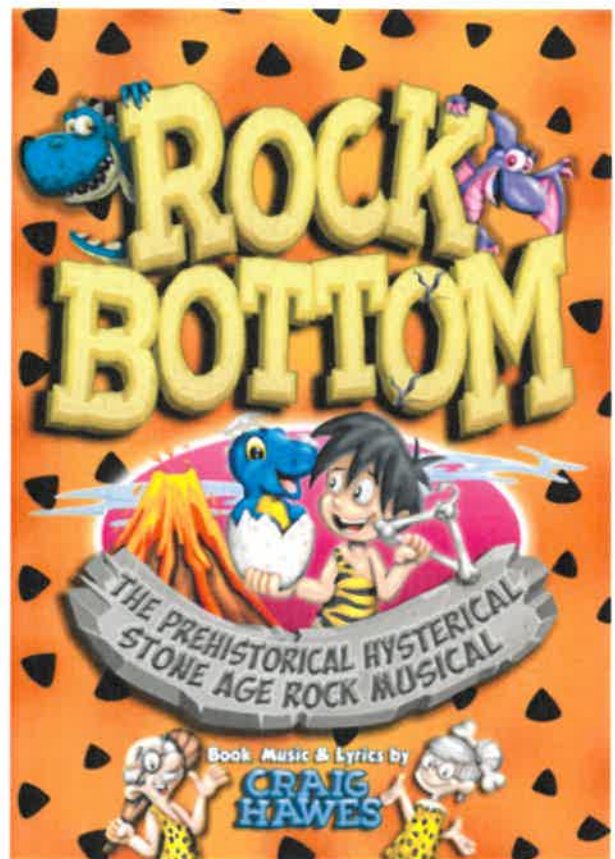

WHĪKOI MO TE REO/MATARIKI CELEBRATIONS

For the commencing of the Maori New Year coinciding with the appearance of the star cluster Matariki in the north eastern dawn sky in late June.

On Wednesday 26th of June the senior Kapahaka Group visited the meeting house Koha-a-Rua, Maniaroa, between Awakino and Mokau to learn about the history of the connection between this area and the Tainui Waka. Whaea Marie and local kaumatua Haumoana White explained the significance of the carvings of the ancestors and the Tainui anchor stone in the urupa. It was a great pleasure to renew my acquaintance with him after many years. Taranaki maunga was a magnificent sight on a clear but frosty morning.

On Thursday 25th June Aria Primary joined the Whikoi down Te Kuiti's Rora Street to the Les Munro Centre, and presented a history of the Tainui canoe which they have been studying. Many thanks, as ever, to Whaea Marie, Miss Johnston and Mrs Voyce, also to all parents and caregivers involved, it is always a pleasure to take part in this event.

Risk & Mitigation Workshops

Presented by King Country River Care and
Waikato Regional Council

How to turn a threat into an opportunity!

The workshop session will introduce the benefits of completing Farm Environment planning for your farm business. We will discuss what "good environmental farm management" looks like – how to identify issues and make changes.

The farm tour will allow you to gather information on potential environmental risks and "critical source areas" on farm and some options to help mitigate these. We will look at 2 sites on farm and have discussion from local farmers and WRC staff about the possible actions to take on farm – what works for farmers and what hasn't.

We will complete day with a session to discuss possible projects and future planning within your subcatchment group areas.
