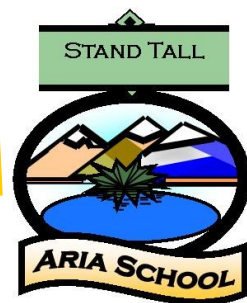

## Principal's News Continued...

- ♦ **Year 6 Transition...** to Piopio College - a visit to PPC is planned for Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> October from 9.00am until 1.00pm.

During the morning our students will work with the current year 7 students to experience a typical day. Students can travel in the morning by normal school bus, however we will need to arrange a pick up at lunchtime to return them to school.
