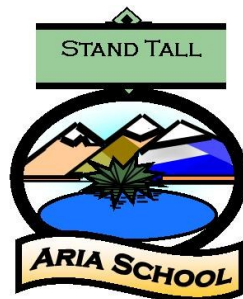

## Our Minivan Rules
