# Principal's News...

## Welcome to Week 9

- Student Health... Most students have settled back into school routines well but are still struggling with maintaining focus for a full day's learning. Many are very tired by the end of the week and I urge you most strongly to encourage more sleep time if at all possible.
- ♦ School Production... This week on Tuesday (tomorrow) and Wednesday I will be holding auditions for next term's school production "Porridge". Most children have chosen parts that they would like to try out for and are hopefully practising a few parts ready for their audition. Please check with them tonight.
- ♦ Mid Year Assessment... During the next three weeks staff will be completing assessments to be sent home on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June.

Usually at mid-year reporting time we would have completed close to 20 weeks of teaching. This year due to the corona virus we will have completed only 13 weeks for many children and less for others.

This year's mid-year written reports will be a shortened version of our usual report, similar to the one sent home at the end of term one in previous years. The assessment folders (clear files) will also be somewhat smaller than usual.

- ◆ Parent interviews... will be held during the last week of term 2 on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> June. Please phone the office to arrange a mutually suitable time to discuss your children's progress with their teachers. I suggest that you bring their reports and/or assessment folders with you. Students can attend their interview with you if you wish.
- Pet Day (calves, lambs and goats)... Our annual Pet Day will be held during the first week of term 4 (14<sup>th</sup> October). A full schedule of activities (indoor and outdoor) with details will be sent home in week 6 of next term. This will include seeds to be grown and judged on the day.

NB. Calves will be included this year.

**Hockey...** is starting this week. All teams will play on Thursday in Te Kuiti and will run till the end of term 2. The draw will be sent out this week.
