

Thank you to Kerry Te Kanawa, master carver and kaumatua Abe Mita, for his blessings of the site before and after the work's completion. We are grateful also to Charlie Winikerei and Peter Foss for the big part they played alongside our Principal Pam Voyce and the Aria school staff.

The sign is a legacy of the foresight of the late Rose Stockman and Peggy Tohengaroa, who encouraged the inclusion of Maori culture into Aria School in the early 90s. Today the school is held up as a shining example of what can be achieved by including Te Reo in the curriculum.

On the day the children performed waiata and the school patere, concluding with a rousing haka from the boys supported by the girls.
