Principal's News...

Welcome to 2020!

Happy New Year to you all! I hope the holidays have been great family times and you feel ready to tackle a new school year!

This newsletter includes a few reminders for you before school starts on **Monday 3rd February**.

Bring to school; Sunhat, Togs and towel (**every day**), pen, pencil, **contact detail form** (corrected if necessary), if we do not receive one by the end of the week we will assume current details are correct.

- ♦ **Waitangi Day...** Thursday 6th February. School will be closed.
- ♦ **Swimming...** is a compulsory part of the curriculum, if your child isn't swimming we do need a note please. We will phone to check arrangements immediately after school as you may not be aware that your child is choosing not to swim or leaving togs at home.
- ♦ **2020 Two Day Trail Bike Event...** Aria School's annual fundraiser will be happening on Saturday 15th & Sunday 16th February this year - great family weekend out.

- ♦ **Absences...** If your child is going to be absent/late for the day please notify the school office before 9.00am each day.
- ♦ **Hats...** are COMPULSORY. All students **MUST** have a **NAMED** hat that is to be left **AT SCHOOL**.
- ♦ **School Newsletter...** Is sent home to all school families on the first school day of each week (usually Monday) and delivered to the wider community either on a Tuesday or Thursday. Thank-you to Donald MacRae and Peter Carey for their continuing support of Aria School by delivering the school newsletter on the Aria and Mokauiti RD.

Any advertisements or notices to be included in our newsletter must be received by the school office by Friday 3.00pm. We will be unable to include any late requests received over the weekend or on Monday.

- ♦ **2020 Class List...** is included. If you know of any other new entrants to come this year please contact the office.
- ♦ **Stationery...** All school families will find attached to this newsletter the stationery requirements for their child/ren. All students will be expected to have their stationery by the start of Week 2. All items can be purchased through the school. Please send the form back to school with the required items clearly marked. We will endeavour to return stationery purchases home within 2 days of receiving the order to enable you to check that your purchase is correct. Please return items back to school named. (Room 3 and Room 2 students are required to return **all** extra named pencils too as these will be held at school).
- ♦ **Canteen...** Operates every **Monday and Friday** and will be **open from WEEK 1**, however there are limited items for sale until our **first order arrives**.

Lunch orders are taken at the school office between 8.15am - 8.30am. Please remind your child if they are ordering lunch to do it at this time, (lunch orders **will not be** taken during class time) if your child forgets they will need to order their lunch at 10.00am. Please make sure your child brings their money in either a coin purse, sealed envelope or a snap lock bag so they can keep their change secure. Food brought from home can also be heated up on **Monday and Friday**; this needs to be clearly named and put in the blue plastic container located outside room 1 before school starts.

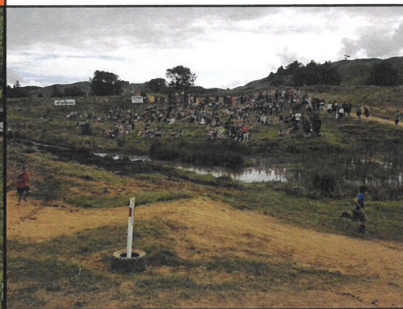
